Mount Harmon Plantation is one of Maryland's most beautiful historic sites, spectacular for its waterfront setting on the Sassafras River in Cecil County. We will take a one-hour, guided tour of the 18th century manor house and colonial kitchen. We will have another hour or so to walk through the formal boxwood garden, Education & Discovery Center, tobacco prize house, and nature trails.

Lunch at the popular Chesapeake Inn, located on the waterfront in historic Chesapeake City, begins around 12:30 or 1:00 PM. The menu will consist of your choice of a tossed salad or crab bisque, an entree choice of Tortelloni Primavera, Chicken Marsala or Jumbo Lump Crab Cake, and the Chef's choice of our dessert.

After lunch, explore Chesapeake City, a charming Victorian town situated on the banks of the C & D Canal. We hope to include the C & D Canal Museum on this leg of the trip. The town has many restored historic homes, shops and galleries. We will head for home at 4 PM, returning to Immanuel by 6 PM.
